

The following instructions will guide you through the parent login for Math in Focus:

For Kindergarten through Fifth Grade:

1. Go to <https://www-k6.thinkcentral.com/ePC/start.do>

2. State: “Colorado”

District: “Private School”

School: “Heritage Christian Academy, Fort Collins 80524”

User Name and Password can be acquired from your child’s teacher or by emailing math@hertiagechristian.info

3. Click “Log In”

Once you are logged in:

1. Clicking the “Think Central” logo on the top left at any time will return you to the home page

2. “My Library” is where you will find your student books

Click on a book to view its contents

For Text Books:

- Choose Volume A or Volume B (top yellow tabs)
- Put in a page number (bottom) or search for a word (top)
- Pages may be printed using “Print” function (Ctrl P on Windows), but the clarity and size are not great. Be sure to use “Landscape” not “Portrait” setting

For Workbooks:

- Choose chapter
- Choose section
- Pages may be saved or printed (top left) –these are pdf’s and are much better quality for printing than the text books.

Sixth grade math login information:

1. Go to my.hrw.com
2. Username: “sgrader23”
3. Password: “HCAmath”
4. Click “Log In”
5. Choose the textbook from the list on the right.

6. Select the chapter and lesson from the pull-down menu on top.
7. ~If you have trouble, check to see that you have the necessary plug-ins installed on your computer (box on right).
8. Each lesson has tabs that contain different resources available to you.
 - i. Book Pages—this is the actual text book pages
 - ii. Student Resources—includes activities, extra worksheets, vocabulary review, and much more.
 - iii. Videos and Tools—interactives, manipulatives, calculators, and tutorial videos.
 - iv. Parent Resources—videos to help you understand and aid in your student’s understanding of concepts
 - v. Transition Resources—this is a wonderful tool to help fill in the missing gaps that could arise from not using the *Math in Focus* curriculum in previous grades.
 - i. Transition Resource Map—includes all the chapters from the entire year and tells you where to locate help on each concept. This is only a list. Resources must be accessed through the applicable chapter, i.e. in order to find the help for NS 28, “Use bar models to show the four operations” you must go to Chapter 7 and find the resources under “Skills”.
 - ii. Skills—these will give you background tools for these particular concepts found in the chapter
